#### IC-DISC

If a closely held company earns significant income from exporting US-made products, it may be a good idea to form an 'Interest Charge Domestic International Sales Corporation' (IC-DISC). An IC-DISC is relatively inexpensive to set up and operate, and it can reduce the federal tax rate on a portion of net export income by up to 20 percentage points. You benefit from establishing an IC-DISC by having your ordinary income taxed at only a 15 percent tax rate.

## Research & Development (R&D) Tax Credits

The Research & Development Tax Credit can provide an immediate source of cash for your business, including a significant reduction to current and future year's Federal and State tax liabilities. If your business has invested time, money and resources, in other words, your sweat equity, towards the advancement and improvement of its products or processes, then you may qualify for the R&D tax credit.

The following is a short list of innovations eligible for a food and beverage business to claim the Research & Development tax credit:

- Developing recipe formulations for new food products/flavoring
- · Developing new testing methods or protocols
- · Innovations to improve a product's shelf life
- · Creating new or improved products with desirable characteristics
- · Developing new or improved techniques or formulas
- Developing new or improved manufacturing processes
- Implementation of automation processes
